All parts of Computer Services for You, LLC software and products are copyright protected.


##### 1.3. Limitation of responsibility

## Battery Life Service

BatteryLifeService.exe

### Description:

BatteryLifeService is a service application used to monitor the battery status. It creates a log file “C:\Battery.log” in a tab delimited format with the following columns:

This service is a single .exe file that uses the power management API in windows to monitor the battery / AC status. It has not been package with an install program to keep the size to a minimum.

### Installation:

- Copy the service “BatteryLiveService.exe” to a directory desired for this custom service.
- In a DOS / Command prompt (Start / Run... / cmd.exe)
- Change directory to the location the service “BatteryLiveService.exe” was copied to.
- Run the command “BatteryLiveService.exe /INSTALL” to install the service
- Close out of the command prompt by running the command “EXIT”
- The service will be started at the next reboot.

### Un-Installing:

- In a DOS / Command prompt (Start / Run... / cmd.exe)
- Change to the drive and directory location the service “BatteryLiveService.exe” was copied to.
- Run the command “BatteryLiveService.exe /UNINSTALL” to mark the service for deletion
- Close out of the command prompt by running the command “EXIT”
- Reboot the PC to finalize the removal.
