



## 1. Installation

Download of **hipoqih.com** plugin is a ZIP file. Must be decompress before installing it.

According to the platform and selected version the installation is different, as we explain next:

- **PDA Version for Windows Mobile:** Plugin previously needs to have installed the .NET Compact Framework 2.0 (it is possible to download [here](#)). Next, you copy the **hipoqihPDA.inf** and **hipoqihPDA.cab** archives to the PDA and open this last one, so that the installation begins. A folder in “Archives of Program” is created with the plugin and the configuration file. An entrance in “Programs” of the PDA is also created.
- **PC Version for Windows XP:** Plugin previously needs to have installed the .NET Framework 2.0 (if it does not exists it will be unloaded and installed automatically). To initiate the installation, open the **setup.exe** file. That installs plugin, creates the folder **\program files\hipoqih** with all the archives necessary to use plugin, and an entrance in the menu of Windows.

## 2. Configuration

Plugin has a configuration Window, explained in the manual. First you must record your key and user of **hipoqih.com** and the type of location system that you want to use. The plugin configuration is in the file **CONFIG.XML**. That must be in the same folder in which plugin is installed.

Next we explain the parameters of the configuration:

- **<lat>43,362005</lat>** and **<lon>-8,412179</lon>**: The coordinates of the user in case he has not a GPS.
- **<tick>5</tick>**: Number of seconds between each shipment of the position when plugin is connected and the user is moving.
- **<tack>50</tack>**: Number of seconds between each shipment of the position when plugin is connected and the user is stopped.
- **<gps>GPS</gps>**: Localization system type. The values are:
  - **GPS**: System with GPS connected.
  - **NONE**: Position read from configuration.
  - **FILE**: Position read from file.
- **<auto>False</auto>**: The values are:
  - **True**: It indicates that the warnings will open directly in the navigator as soon as they arrive.

- **False:** When a warning arrives, plugin shows the associated text and asks whether you want to open it or not.
- **<map>False</map>**: The values are:
  - **True:** Indicates that the warnings will be open first on the map.
  - **False:** Indicates that the warnings will directly open the URL associated to the warning.
- **<width>240</width>**: Width of the navigator window to show the warnings.
- **<height>320</height>**: Height of the navigator window to show the warnings.
- **<top>0</top>**: The distance from the superior edge of the screen to where the navigator window is located.
- **<left>0</left>**: The distance from the left edge of the screen to where the navigator window is located.
- **<port>COM1</port>**: Port for the GPS device or **NONE**.
- **<speed>9600</speed>**: Speed of transmission of port COM or **NONE**.
- **<user>user</user>**: **hipoqih.com** login.
- **<pass>password</pass>**: **hipoqih.com** password.
- **<lang>ES</lang>**: Language chosen for plugin. The allowed values are ES (spanish) / EN (english).
- **<song>NONE</song>**: File of sound that is used when a warning arrives. **NONE** to use plugin without sound.
- **<explorer>hipoqih</explorer>**: Navigator used to see warnings. If you write “hipoqih” the internal navigator of plugin will be used. If you want to use any other, you must write the name and the complete route (for example, a valid value is “C:\Program Files\Mozilla Firefox\firefox.exe”).
